Here's what to wear:

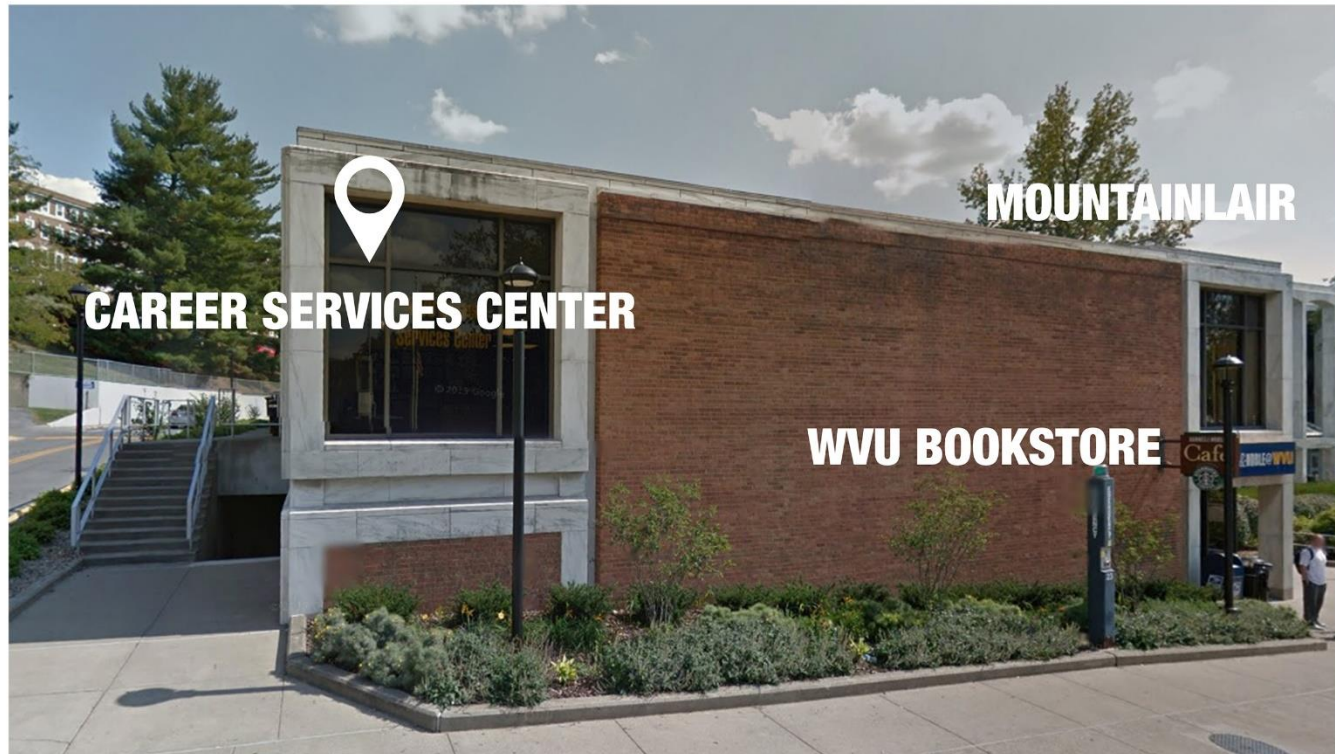
- / Nice pants/slacks
